

About the Pegge Haywood Annual Scholarship

Administered by the Cabarrus County Republican Party

Who is Pegge Haywood?

Pegge Haywood (10/29/24 to 3/18/06) was a dedicated Republican citizen of Cabarrus county. Pegge was a life-long Republican, and attended several national conventions as a delegate. Pegge was the owner of the Pegge Lee School of Dance for 40 years. She was a graduate of Concord High School, Virginia Intermont College, as well as a graduate of the Chalif School of Dance. She was active in the American Red Cross, and served as vice president and board member of Historic Cabarrus. She was president of the Cabarrus Arts Council and chair of the Social Service Board of Cabarrus. Pegge also served on the board of Meals on Wheels.

Where does this money come from?

Pegge Haywood left a generous gift to the Cabarrus County Republican Party in her Will, and in honor of Pegge the GOP board voted to create an annual scholarship award to be given to a college-bound high school student who displays a commitment to the party by his or her activities.

Why is this scholarship being given?

It is our hope that this scholarship will encourage public service, charitable work and a commitment to Republican ideals among young persons pursuing advanced study, as well as encourage the kinds of selfless work to which Pegge Haywood dedicated her life.

The following paragraph is excerpted from a document creating the scholarship:

The application process will award the scholarship to an outstanding individual who demonstrates a commitment to Republican principles expressed by participation in party activities, and a brief essay submitted with their application. The applicant's choice of college major need not be politically oriented or aimed at public service.

When will the scholarship be awarded and how?

The award will be announced about the time of the party's Reagan Day Dinner (generally in April), and a check will be made payable to the college of the award winner's choice on their behalf.

Applicants must also live in Cabarrus County.

At this time we are limiting applications to young people entering their first year of college.
